2. SOCIALS

Thursday 22nd April

We shall play party games that we used to when we were young. Each committee member is to come up with a game each. Bex insisted on doing pass the parcel as she enjoys the wrapping!

3. EASTER CAMP



Easter Camp is to be held next weekend between Friday 30th April and Sunday 2nd May at the Penmaen Guide Campsite, the same location as last year. Claire confirmed that the site is booked and Tom is in possession of the keys to the site.



An email has been sent to graduates inviting them, although none to date have confirmed that they shall be in attendance. An email shall be sent tomorrow (22nd April) to members inviting them to the camp.

- ✿ We shall be meeting at 6pm and getting to Penmaen by car, should we have enough drivers, or by bus if not. Bus times will be investigated by Bex. There will also be the option of walking, if anyone wishes to join Shaun!
- ✿ The main activity will be an afternoon at Perriswood on Saturday, where we have been booked onto the tea, archery and falconry package, costing £12 per person. This includes an archery session of 12 arrows per person although we can book an hour lesson for an additional £3 per person. We decided that, unless attendance is very poor, we will not be booking the lesson as this would reduce the number of arrows per person, and there will be supervision where members require some assistance in firing.
- ✿ On the Saturday morning we shall have a walk to Wormshead and Rhossilli, perhaps stopping at Mewslade Bay. We still have the SSWIGS beach tools which can be taken. From the beach, we can walk back to site via Perriswood, however, buses shall once more be investigated.
- ✿ Sunday morning shall consist of games on the beach. Need to take balls and perhaps cricket bat.
- ✿ The menu has been sent around on email. A few changes upon Tom's initial menu were agreed. Rather than hotdogs on the Friday night, we shall have a pasta carbonara (or similar) as this will be more filling, especially if we are getting members to meet fairly early. We shall also swap the fry-up from Sunday breakfast to the Saturday and have bacon and sausage sandwiches for Sunday's breakfast. No provision for puddings had been made either: Friday's pudding shall be custard and cake and there will be a choice on Saturday with a fruit and jelly tart and Tom's angel delight cake. All the cooking equipment is at the site ready for us to use.

4. HANDOVER

- ✿ Handover should be complete by Easter Camp when the existing committee retires and the new committee assumes responsibilities for the society.
- ✿ It was decided that rather than conduct a group handover, it would be easier to have individual meetings. This way the retiring member can show their successor the tasks involved with the specific role.
- ✿ However, it was decided that it would be good for us to have a committee meal together. This shall be held at Miah's on Tuesday 4th May.
- ✿ Claire will send an email to the new committee with information upon organising individual handover meetings and the handover meal.

5. AOB

- ✿ Shaun is organising a SSWIGS rugby trip to watch the Ospreys at the Liberty Stadium on Friday 7th May. Details will be sent out to members in a near social email
