Meeting Started at 4.10pm

1. Kate opened the meeting

2. Handover
 - Each Member of the new committee filled in their details and singed the Handover pack. After this was complete Kate said she would check it and hand it in to the SU.
 - Ed had received the Accounts from Dawn (2009-2010 Treasurer) and they were then discussed with the rest of the committee.

3. Fresher's Fair
 - Kate told the rest of the committee that she had booked a site for fresher's fair. But very little was known about it yet, and more details would be given about it nearer to the time.
 - Ideas were discussed as to how we would get ourselves noticed at the fair one idea was to make welsh cakes (if the SU would allow us to). Also the idea of handouts and having a PowerPoint slid show of photos of the society and an information board were brought up. There was still also talk of a sheep suit. Everyone was decided that being proactive would be the best way forward.
 - The idea was also discussed of giving something away for free at fresher's fair (Other SSAGO clubs do this to attracts new members). Some ideas discussed were kit or a SSWIGS badge. But it was decided a free BBQ as a social sometime early next year would be the best idea. This idea was decided because it would cheap and easy to

organise. It would also not only be good for attracting new members at the fresher's fair but also a good way of maybe making more members come to socials.

4. Fresher's Camp

- Since the last meeting Kate had looked in to scout huts in the local area. The best option was one near Swansea. SSWIGS had visited the hut before, but very few of those members who had would be here next year so it would not be a problem visiting again. The hut also had bunk beds this would be good for fresher's camp, as it is held indoors, it is also good as not much kit would need to be taken as very few fresher's have a lot of kit so early on in the year.
- Activities for fresher's camp were also discussed. The main activity of the weekend would be a visit to Dan yr ogof caves. Other activities would include a hike/walk, silly games and a camp fire. Another idea was to get all members involved with the cooking, because at other camps people have felt this is where a lot of time is wasted as they get bored. So ideas like cooking on a camp fire and group cooking were disused.

5. Thursdays social (10.06.2010)

- The idea is to have a beach BBQ. We agreed to meet at 7 on the beach, Kate would buy the food, and we would charge £2.50. We also decided as this was the last SSWIGS social of the year we would have a SSWIGS awards ceremony. As it would be informal we decided to only give a few serious awards and silly awards to the rest of the members. A Certificate and toy medal would be bought for each member.

6. Any Other Business

- The SSWIGS badges that were ordered have arrived, we would start selling them as soon as possible and charge £1 each for them.
- A new order of polo shirts and hoodies was to me made, along with a order for plate bags.
- It was decided that all emails from now on should use the undisclosed recipient option, so email addresses cannot be read by anyone.
- Ideas were discussed for rally fancy dress, some members had recommended jesters, so this would be suggested to everyone going on rally to see how they felt about it.
